

Chicken AND Pen (coop) Permit Requirements

- <u>SRA (Sabine River Authority) Property</u> If the building structure is on SRA land you must provide a copy of SRA permit to build before the City can issue a permit
- 1 Set of Site Plans A landscape plan, and a detailed drawing of proposed improvements to a given lot to include:

Legal description (lot, block, subdivision)
Property lines & lot dimensions
All easements
Proposed structure & all existing buildings
Setbacks for front, rear & sides

• 1 Set of Building Plans – Construction or working drawing (blueprints) that define all the construction specification of the structure such as dimensions, materials, layouts, installation methods and techniques to include:

Floor plan
Exterior plan
Roof design
Construction details
Wood/Material details

NOTE: if pre-made kit, please see attached example for specifications

NOTE: IF a concrete slab foundation will be constructed there is an additional permit fee

- <u>Inspection of Pen (coop)</u> Once construction is completed owner **must** contact City Hall for a building inspection of the structure on the property. Failure to contact City Hall for the inspection can cause a permit to become null and void as stated on the permit application signed by the applicant.
- Registration of Chicken(s) Once a building inspection has passed all requirements and restrictions owner must register each chicken. Owner must provide the number of chickens and a description/color of each chicken. Owner will be given a poultry leg band provided by the City with an identification number for each chicken. Leg bands must be attached to the leg of each chicken at all times. Failure to register and/or have identification bands can cause revocation of permit as stated to comply with all provisions of the City Ordinances on the permit application signed by the applicant.
- <u>Impromptu Inspections</u> Owner is subject to future inspections as foreseen by the Chief of Police. To ensure pen (coop) is being properly maintained. Waste is being properly disposed of. To ensure the number of chickens is six (6) or less and identification bands are on each chicken. Failure to comply with these regulations can cause revocation of permit as stated to comply with all provisions of the City Ordinances on the permit application signed by the applicant.

NOTICE: per city ordinance Ch. 66 Utilities, Art. II, Dev. 1, Sec. 66-32 Utility Easements – Easement accessibility

NOTE: once application and plans are received and reviewed more information may be requested for completion.


